Repeated signs of illness will result in an automatic temporary withdrawal of one week.

Please continue to help us educate your child with the proper health procedures as outlined at https://www.hhs.gov/. If you decide to keep your child home, you will be allowed to use a vacation credit. Due to the lack of space, we will not be able to accommodate Before & After care children.

These are extraordinary times, and we're taking extraordinary precautions to stay on top and ahead of any spread of colds, flu, and other viruses at AWOHCCC. We're monitoring the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) website, we're in regular contact with local health officials, and we're following what the government is doing for protection.
